## **Watermark Sensor Puller**

## **User Instructions**

Simply clamp the locking pliers,
with the extended jaws, on the sensor.
Rotate 180 degrees side to side
to loosen the sensor.





Now hook the loop on the jack handle, under the pin on the locking pliers

Put one hand on the locking pliers
and the other hand on the jack handle.
This will stabilize the sensor
while you pull it out. For long sensors
simply release the locking pliers
and slide it down on the sensor
to get another bite.



If sensor does not pull easily, and to avoid damage, pour water in a hole that is dug next to the sensor shaft.

After a few minutes, rotate the locking pliers/shaft back and forth to loosen sensor.

Attempt to pull again. Repeat as necessary

Fold jack flat for easy carrying and storage.
